


THE BOARD

- Maintain a Registry of Practicing Professionals and Licenses.
- Hold examinations for enabling persons to qualify for registration under the order.
- Approve or reject applications.
- Cancel, remove or reinstate registration.

- Establish, maintain and develop standards of professional conduct and ethics.

- Promote learning and education of the professions under the order.
- Hear and determine disputes related to professional conduct and ethics.
- Appoint arbitrators for the purpose of hearing and determining disputes between registered practitioners.



THE Board of Architects, Professional Engineers and Quantity Surveyors (BAPEQS) will organise the Architect, Professional Engineer and Quantity Survey (APEQS) Order 2011 Awareness Roadshow at the Public Works Department Headquarters in Berakas for the oovernment and private sectors on January 26 and 28.

The objective of BAPEQS is to grant authorisation to qualified architects, professional engineers and quantity surveyors to practise in Brunei, while maintaining and developing standards of professional conducts and ethics among its registered professionals.

In line with the Brunei Vision 2035, BAPEQS continues to supply and propagate quality professionals enabling Brunei to be recognised for its educated and skilled citizens, measured by the highest international standards.

- (1) Renewal of registration submission is set to be in the month of November each calendar year.
- (2) Registered Professional's registration is valid for two (2) years Renewable by application. Condition applies.
- (3) Practising Certificate is valid for one (1) year Renewal by application. Condition applies. E.g

 <u>CPE point</u> (Under 60 year of age = 25 CPE Points, 60 above and under 70 years of age = 20 CPE

 Points and 70 above year of age = 15 CPE Points) effective 9th March 2019

EXCEPTION OF THE ORDER



p.386-3(1),(2),(3)

ORDER NOT TO APPLY TO GOVERNMENT

- The Government or Public Officer under the authority of the Government.
- Public authority in Brunei Darussalam under the provisions of any written law to obtain a licence.

"Public authority" – any body established by or under any written law and exercising powers vested therein by any written law for a public purpose.

DEFINITION TO 'BUILDING'



P.384 – "building"

- (a) a hut, shed or roofed enclosure which includes a kiosk or stall, movable or otherwise;
- (b) an earth retaining or stabilizing structure, whether permanent or temporary;
- (c) a dock, wharf or jetty
- (d) a floating structure, not being a boat or vessel, constructed or to be constructed on a floatation system that
 - (i) is or is to be supported by water;
 - (ii) is not intended for or useable in navigation; and
 - (iii) is or is to be permanently moored;
- (e) A culvert, crossing, access road, bridge, underpass or tunnel;
- (f) A sewerage treatment plant, sewer, drain, swimming pool or any nonproprietory type of concrete tank for the storage of any solid, liquid or gaseous product; and
- (g) Such other erection or structure (whether permanent or temporary) as the Minister may, by order published in the Gazette, declare to be a building.

DISCIPLINES/ROFESSIONS COVERED UNDER APEQS ORDER

- Engineering Practices (2nd May 2011 and 2nd June 2017)

 - Electrical Engineering

 - Building Services Engineering
 - Chemical Engineering
 - Environmental Engineering
 - Structural Engineering
 - * Such other branches of engineering as may be prescribed

DEFINITION TO ARCHITECTURAL & QUANTITY SURVEYING SERVICES



p.383 -

"architectural services"

 includes selling or supplying for gain or reward any architectural plan, drawing, tracing or the like for use in the construction, enlargement or alteration of any building or part thereof.

Section 12 p.395 -

"quantity surveying services"

 includes preparing of cost feasibility study reports, preliminary estimates, cost plans, documents and reports for pre-qualification of contractors, bills of quantities and other tender documents, tender estimates and reports, contract documents and valuations of works for interim payments, variation and final accounts.





p.385 -

"professional engineering services"

- Means consultancy or advisory services that require a person to engage in professional engineering work.

"professional engineering work"

Includes any service, consultation, investigation, evaluation, planning, design
or responsible supervision of construction or operation in connection with
any public or privately owned public utilities, buildings, machines,
equipment, processes, works or projects wherein the public interest and
welfare, or the safeguarding of life, public health or property is concerned or
involved, and that requires the application of professional engineering
principles and data.



PART III-p.391 to 397 – Illegal architectural/professional engineering/quantity surveying practice

- (1) Subject to the provisions of this Order, **no person shall engage** in any of the prescribed branches of **architectural**, **professional engineering and quantity surveying** work in Brunei Darussalam unless he/she is;
 - (a) a registered architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor who has in force a practising certificate authorising him/her to engage in that branch of architectural/professional engineering/quantity surveying work;
 - (b) under the direction or supervision of a registered architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor who has in force a practising certificate authorising the registered professional to engage in that branch of architectural/professional engineering/quantity surveying work; or
 - (c) **authorised by the Board to work in collaboration** (but without a right to any independent practice) with a registered architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor who has in force a practising certificate authorising the registered architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor to engage in that branch of architectural/professional engineering/quantity surveying work.

Architectural Practice

10.(3)

Subject to the provisions of this Order, no person shall **sign and submit** to a building authority or to a public authority -

- (a) any plan, drawing, tracing, design, specification or other document intended to govern the construction, enlargement or alteration of any building or part thereof in Brunei Darussalam; or
- (b) any report on or a certificate or other document relating to the construction, enlargement or alteration of any building or part thereof which is required by any written law to be signed by an architect.

unless he/she is a registered architect who has in force a practising certificate.

Professional Engineering Practice

11.(3)

Subject to the provisions of this Order, no person shall **sign and submit** to a building authority or to a public authority -

- (a) any plan, sketch, drawing, design, specification or other document relating to any professional engineering work in Brunei Darussalam; or
- (b) any report on or a certificate or other document relating to any professional engineering work in Brunei Darussalam which is required by any written law to be signed by a professional engineer,

unless he/she is a registered professional engineer who has in force a practising certificate authorizing him to engage in such branch of professional engineering work.



[cont'd] PART III-p.391 to 397 – Illegal architectural/professional engineering/quantity surveying practice

Quantity Surveying Practice

12.(3)

Subject to the provisions of this Order, no person shall **sign and submit** to a building authority or to a public authority -

- (a) any estimate, cost plan, bills of quantities or other document relating to any quantity surveying work in Brunei Darussalam; or
- (b) any report, valuation of work, certificate or other document relating to any quantity surveying work in Brunei Darussalam which is required by any written law to be signed by the a quantity surveyor.

unless he/she is a registered quantity surveyor who has in force a practising certificate.

REMUNERATION AND EMPLOYMENT OF SERVICES



PART III-p.397 & 398

- ➤ **No person shall be entitled to recover** in any court and charge, fee or remuneration for any architectural, professional engineering or quantity surveying services rendered in Brunei Darussalam unless he is authorized by this order to supply any of those services.
- No person shall employ as an architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor who is neither a registered architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor nor has in force a practicing certificate.



PART III-p.391 to 397

Subject to provisions of this Order, no person shall use verbally or otherwise;

- (a) the words "architect"/"professional engineer" or "engineer" /"quantity Surveyor" or "building economist" or "building cost consultant" or any additions to or derivative of those words in connection with his designation;
- (b) the abbreviation "Ar." or "Arch"/"Ir." or "Er."/"QS" or "Sr." as a title before his/her name; or
- (c) any word, name or designation that might lead to the belief that he/she is a registered architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor, unless he/she is a registered architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor.



PART III-p.391 to 397

10/11/12.(6)

Subject to the provisions of this Order, no person shall **advertise** or **hold him/herself out** or **conduct him/herself** in any way or by any means as a person who is **authorised to supply architectural/professional engineering/quantity surveying services** in Brunei Darussalam, unless he/she is ;

- (a) a registered architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor who has in force a practicing certificate;
- (b) a licensed body corporate;
- (c) a licensed partnership;
- (d) a **licensed** limited liability partnership; or
- (e) a partnership consisting wholly of **registered architects/professional engineers/quantity surveyors**.



PART III-p.391 to 397

10(8)/11(8)/12(8)

Subject to the provisions of this Order, no person shall **supply** or **offer to supply architectural/professional engineering/quantity surveying services** in Brunei Darussalam unless he/she is ;

- (a) a registered architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor who has in force a practising certificate authorising him/her to engage in architectural/ professional engineering/quantity surveying work to which those services relate, and is doing so on his/her own account or as a partner in a licensed partnership or a partnership consisting wholly of registered architects/ professional engineers/quantity surveyors who each has in force a practising certificate;
- (b) an **allied professional** and is doing so only by reason of being a partner in a **licensed partnership**; or
- (c) a licensed body corporate or limited liability partnership.

Refer to PART VI p.406 to 411 for details of (a), (b) and (c) above.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION



PART IV-p.399 to 401

17.(1) Following persons shall, on payment of the prescribed fee, be entitled to registration;

- (a) any person who is a corporate member of an institution recognized by the Board; or E.g PUJA (Route 1 and 2 [Except Architecture]), RIBA, ICE, IChemE, IMechE, RICS, AIQS, IStructE, CIBSE, IET, etc..
- (b) any person who holds any degree, diploma or any other qualification which the Board may approve for the purpose of entitling him to be a registered architect, a registered professional engineer or a registered quantity surveyor under this Order; or
- (c) any person who satisfies the Board that he is otherwise qualified by having proper and recognized training in architecture or who has academic qualifications in professional engineering or quantity surveying and who passes such examinations as may be required by the Board.
- **17.(2)** No person shall be entitled to registration under subsection (1) unless he satisfies the Board that he has, after obtaining his qualifications, acquired not less than 2 years of such practical experience in architectural, professional engineering or quantity surveying work as may be prescribed or approved by the Board (including practical experience in architectural, professional engineering or quantity surveying work in Brunei Darussalam for a continuous period of at least one year).

QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION - SPECIALIST



PART IV-p.400 – Registration of specialist

18. (1)

- (a) Has sat and **passed such examination** as may be prescribed by the Board, or holds such postgraduate degrees or qualifications or has gained such **special** knowledge in a specialised branch of architectural, engineering or quantity surveying as may be approved by the Board;
- (b) Has such **experience in that specialised** branch of architecture, engineering or quantity surveying as may be required by the Board; and
- (c) Has fulfilled such further conditions as may be specified by the Board.
- **18. (2)** The Board may, with the approval of the Minister, make regulations for all or any of the following purposes;
- (a) Providing for the registration of specialists in any specialised branch of architecture, engineering or quantity surveying;

MULTI-DISCIPLINE AND CORPORATE PRACTICE



PART VI-p.406 to 414 MULTI DISCIPLINE AND CORPORATE PRACTICE

- **27.(1)** the Board may grant to a body corporate <u>a licence</u> to supply architectural, professional engineering or quantity surveying services in Brunei Darussalam if –
- (a) The memorandum of association of that body corporate **provides that a primary object of that body corporate** is to supply architectural, professional engineering or quantity surveying services; and
- (b) the paid-up capital of the body corporate is not less than the amount prescribed by the Minister by notification in the *Gazette*; and
- (c) The articles of association of the body corporate provide that at least a prescribed number (<u>majority</u>) or proportion of its directors shall be registered architects, registered professional engineers or registered quantity surveyors **each of whom have in force a practicing certificate**.
- (d) The business will be under the control and management of a director of the body corporate who -
 - (i) registered architect, professional engineer or a registered quantity surveyor who has in force a practising certificate; and
 - (ii) Is **authorized under a resolution of the board of directors** of the body corporate to make all final decisions on behalf with respect to the requirements of this Order, the rules or any other law; and
- (e) Insured against professional liability (PI).

PARTNERSHIP



PART VI-p.406 to 414

27.(2)/(3)/(4) - PARTNERSHIP

The Board may grant to a partnership NOT consisting wholly of registered architects/professional engineers/quantity surveyors;

- (a) the partnership is one in which <u>only registered</u> architects/professional engineers/quantity surveyors and allied professionals, who each has in force a practicing certificate, have a beneficial interest in the capital assets and profits of the partnership;
- (b) the business of the partnership, so far as it relates to the supply of architectural/professional engineers/quantity surveyors services in Brunei Darussalam, will be **under the control and management of a partner who is a registered** architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor and has in force a practicing certificate.

27.(5) LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIP

[ROCBN – None yet in Brunei. Such registration type is currently work in progress.]

REGULATING THE PRACTICES



PART III-p.391 to 398

10/11/12.(9)

Any person who contravenes subsections 10/11/12.(1), (3), (4), (6) or (8) is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction;

- (a) in respect of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000; and
- (b) in respect of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding \$20,000 and/or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

14.(2)

Any person who contravenes subsection 14.(1), i.e employ an architect/professional engineer/quantity surveyor who is neither registered nor has in force a practicing certificate is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction;

- (a) In respect off a first offence, to a fine not exceeding \$2,000; and
- (b) In respect of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine **not exceeding \$5,000**.



DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES TO CLIENT AND EMPLOYER



Rule 2. p.34

Section 2, 3, 4 and 5.

- > Shall discharge faithfully his duties and responsibilities to his client or employer;
- Do not give advice which does not fully reflect his best professional judgement;
- Engage or advise engage experts and specialist in interest of his/her client or employer;
- Act with prime regard to the public interest;
- Shall not disclose confidential information concerning business affairs or technical processes of his/her client/employer;
- Shall not use information obtained confidentially in the course of his/her assignment;
- > Shall not divulge any confidential findings or studies or actions of a board of which he is a member without the consent of the Board;
- > Apply conditions of contract with entire fairness between his client and the other party to the contract; Act in an impartial manner; and
- Be a Director of or have a substantial financial interest in or be an agent for, any company, firm or person carrying on any business which is or may be involved in the work to which his/her employment relates.

REMUNERATION OF SERVICES



Rule 2. p.34

Section 6.

- Shall be remunerated solely by fees in respect of services he renders, or by a salary payable by his/her employer and shall be debarred from any other source of remuneration in connection with such services rendered;
- Shall not accept any discount, gift, commission or other payment or consideration, in respect of the services he/she renders, from any source other than his Client; Or insert or permit the insertion of any clause in any tender, bill of quantities or other document which provides payment to him/her by a contractor in respect of the services except with the full knowledge and approval of his/her client; and
- Is allowed to receive remuneration/dividend for his service as a director/shareholder from licensed corporation;

PUBLICATIONS OF PRACTICE



Rule 2. p.36

Section 7.

- Not allowed to publicise his/her practice in a manner which is likely to diminish public confidence in the Profession or bring the Profession into disrepute (e.g resulting in criticism in relation to the fees charged, or the quality of the services, as the case may be rendered by other professionals); and
- Not allowed to publicise his/her practice in a manner that may reasonably be regarded as misleading, deceptive, inaccurate, false or in any way unbefitting the dignity of the Profession.

SOLICITING AND SUPPLANTING OF EMPLOYMENT



Rule 2. p.38

Section 8 and 9.

- Shall not canvass or solicit professional employment or offer to make payment for the introduction of such employment;
- > Shall not accept work which involves the giving or receiving of discounts or commissions in consideration for, or as an inducement to, the introduction of clients;
- > Shall not supplant (replace) or attempt to supplant another architect, professional engineer or quantity surveyor; and
- Shall not intervene or attempt to intervene in or in connection with the Work of any kind which to his/her knowledge has already been entrusted to another architect, professional engineer or quantity surveyor.

CONDUCT TOWARDS OTHER PROFESSIONS



Rule 2. p.38

Section 10, 11 and 12.

- Shall at all times, with due regard to the interest of his/her client, act honorably towards other architects, professional engineers and quantity surveyors;
- > Unless approved by the Board, shall not compete with another architect, professional engineer or quantity surveyor by means of a reduction of fees or by any inducement to any person;
- Shall not undertake work where knowingly and without reasonable grounds, accept or continue with an engagement to provide professional services to the Client where knowingly there is a claim and not satisfied made by other architect, professional engineer or quantity surveyor against the Client;
- Shall notify (if known or ascertain by a reasonable inquiry to know) the other engaged architect, professional engineer or quantity surveyor or the Board of APEQS if he/she is approached by the Client for an engagement.

PROFESSIONAL INTEGRITIES OR OBLIGATIONS



Rule 2. p.39

Section 13.

- Shall not act in a manner which is inconsistent or out of keeping with the fitting and proper discharge of his professional duties, raise doubts as to his/her professional integrity, or would raise doubts as to whether he/she will render his/her service in accordance with any written law and with honesty and integrity;
- Shall exercise due restraint in criticizing the work of others;
- > Shall not maliciously or recklessly injure or attempt to injure, directly or indirectly, of the professional reputation, prospects or business of another architect, professional engineer or quantity surveyor;
- Shall <u>refrain from expressing publicly an opinion</u> on an architectural, engineering or quantity surveying project unless the architect, professional engineer or quantity surveyor is informed of the facts relating thereto; and

^{**} The architect, professional engineer and quantity surveyor has a moral obligation to expose unethical conduct before the proper authorities.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST & CONVENTION OF WRITTEN LAW



Rule 2. p.40 and 41.

Section 15.

An Architect, a Professional Engineer or a Quantity Surveyor;

Shall not hold, assume or consciously accept a position in which his/her interest is in conflict with his professional duty to his client without previously informing his/her client of such conflict.

Section 16.

- Shall exercise diligence to ensure that there is no contravention of or failure to comply with any written law; and
- ➤ Upon knowledge, shall immediately report to the relevant competent authorities of any contravention of or failure to comply with any written law by any person in carrying out any building project or works in relation to which he/she is rendering a service.

LIMITATION OF PAYMENT OR CONTACT, ETC & ACTING AS HOUSING DEVELOPER



Rule 2. p.41

Section 17.

An Architect, a Professional Engineer or a Quantity Surveyor;

Shall not be the medium of any payment made on behalf of his employer unless requested by his/her employer and he/she, in connection with any work in which he/she is employed, shall not place any contract or order except with the authority of or on behalf of his employer.

Section 18.

An Architect, a Professional Engineer or a Quantity Surveyor;

> Shall not act as an Architect, a Professional Engineer or a Quantity Surveyor in respect of any project in which he/she is acting as a housing developer.

** Section 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and Part 2 - 1, 2 and 3 are Code of Ethics specific to Architect and

Professional Engineer.
